- 1. PANTS**
 - ☛ Pants must be navy blue, khaki or black and have no designs or extra colors.
 - ☛ Pants must be fitted at the waist and worn at the waist, not below.
 - ☛ **No sagging, pegged, or overly tight pants;** no frays, slits, holes or tears.
 - ☛ **No jeans,** overalls, shorts, dresses, skirts, Cargo, or Capri pants.
- 2. Belts**
 - ☛ All belts should be white, black or a combination of both white and black.
- 3. SHIRTS**
 - ☛ **HS (Solid white); MS, Int./Elementary** All standardized dress shirts from the home campus will be permissible as long as they are collared and portray elementary, middle school, or elementary home campus colors.
 - ☛ **Undershirts** may be solid white or black without pictures or writing.
 - ☛ **Shirts must be tucked in at all times all the way around the waist** so that the belt can be seen at all times; no exposed midriffs.
 - ☛ Shirts should be completely free of holes, tears, slits, etc. with no insignias (Logos)
- 4. SHOES**
 - ☛ Students must wear **TENNIS SHOES** (white or black) with black or white matching laces. The **TENNIS SHOES** must be all black, all white, or a combination of white and black. **No other colors on the shoe will be accepted.**
- 5. ACCESSORIES and GROOMING**
 - ☛ Purses, make-up bags, billfolds, wallets, book bags, and backpacks are not allowed on campus.
 - ☛ Students may not wear sunglasses or head wear of any kind. **Exception: from November 1st to March 1st students may wear "hoodies" to school to cover their heads and protect them from the cold. The hoods may NOT be worn in the classroom.** After March 1st the only cold weather gear that will be allowed are sweat shirts (black, blue, or white) with no logos, thermal under shirt, or zip up jackets with no hoods. Again, **NO** head wear is allowed other than a 'hoodie' during the months clarified above and **ONLY** during those months. After that, no head wear of any kind will be allowed on campus.
 - ☛ **No jewelry at all.** This includes earrings for either males or females, tongue or eye piercings will not be allowed
 - ☛ Students may wear natural-looking makeup to school; however, no make-up, perfume, chap-stick, creams, eye drops, lip gloss, etc. may be brought to school.
 - ☛ Students' hair must be their natural color. Purple, orange, green, blue, etc. are NOT natural colors. Boys' hair must be no longer than the bottom of the shirt collar. No designs or Mohawks.
 - ☛ Feminine sanitary products may be brought but will be searched for possible contraband.
 - ☛ Tattoos will be covered before entering the building with clothing at all times.
- 6. ID Badges**
 - ☛ ID Badges must be worn and visible at all times. A replacement ID is \$5.00
